## Sediment Accumulation in City Owned Ponds



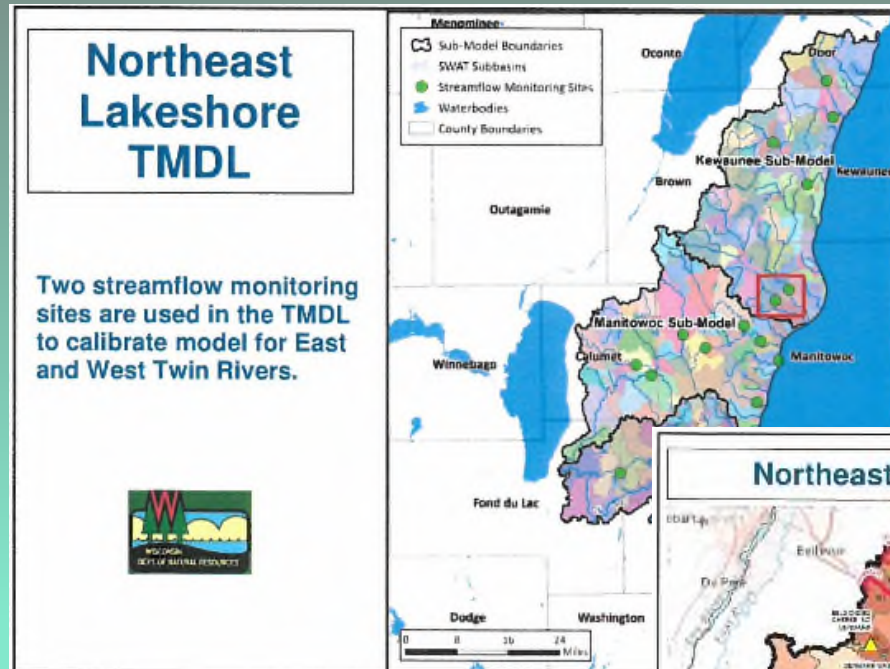

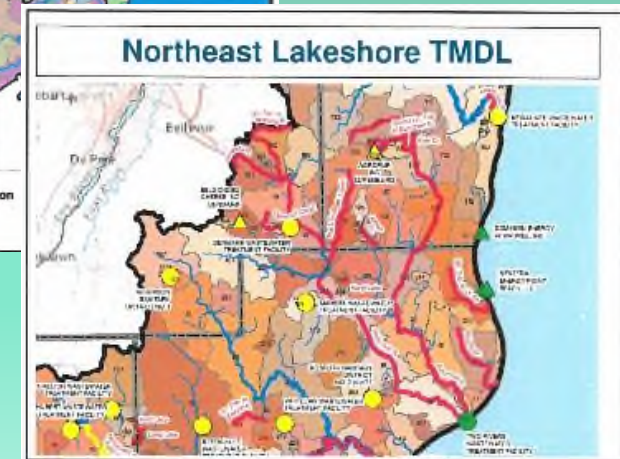

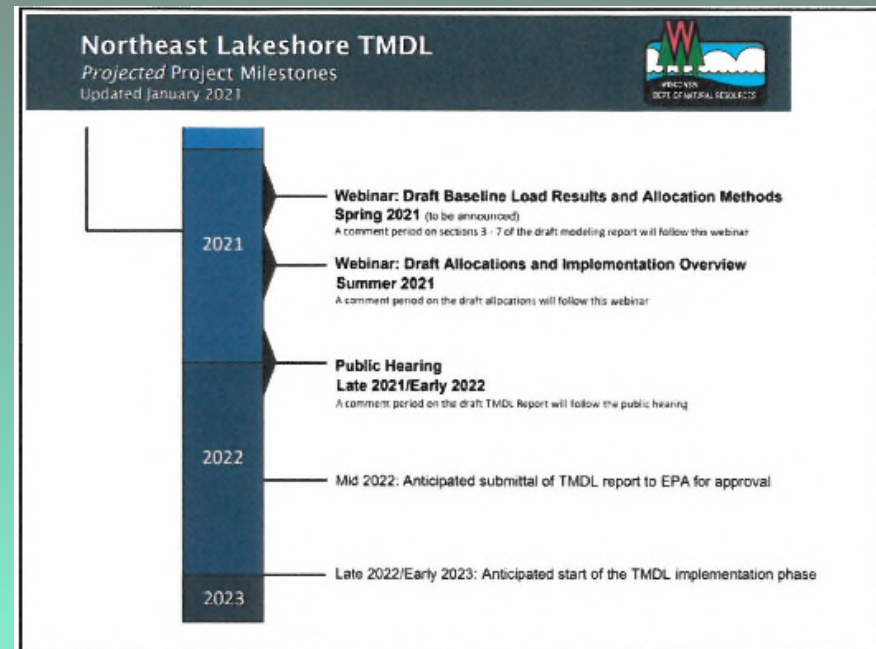
Above: Northeast Lakeshore TMDL Study Area

## What is a TMDL?

A TMDL is the calculation of the maximum amount of a pollutant allowed to enter a waterbody so that the waterbody will meet and continue to meet water quality standards for that particular pollutant. A TMDL determines a pollutant reduction target and allocates load reductions necessary to the source(s) of the pollutant. (USEPA website)
