CEMETERY & FORESTRY WORKER – PART-TIME

Performs a variety of skilled and semi-skilled tasks in the city parks and cemeteries. Turf and tree maintenance, flower planting in cemetery and parks tree and cemetery code enforcement, and other general horticulture requirements of the parks and recreation department. Performs other related duties as assigned.

Works under the general supervision of the Parks & Facilities Supervisor.

Assist with cemeteries operations, City and Park cemetery mowing operations, City flower care and planting, park building seasonal maintenance, Cemetery leaf and snow removal, City forestry-terrace and city property trees, public concerns regarding urban forestry and trees within the City limits, proposal and removal of trees identified as hazardous, dangerous, or dead in City owned facilities and right of ways.

Candidates must possess a high school diploma or GED equivalent, two (2) years of increasingly responsible related experience, or any equivalent combination of related education and experience. Preferably in a public sector environment. Any combination of experience and training which demonstrates the knowledge and experience to perform the work. Certified herbicide applicators license required within 12 months of hire. Commercial Drivers' License endorsement required within 12 months of hire.

Must possess a valid Wisconsin Driver's License. Starting pay is \$12.00 per hour.
