

MATT KONOP MEMORIAL PLAQUE TO BE DEDICATED AT TWO RIVERS CITY HALL, SUNDAY, JULY 1 AT 1 P.M. This memorial plaque hangs on the J. Hruska Building in the Two Rivers Sister City of Domazlice, Czech Republic, to honor Matt Konop for his role in liberating Domazlice, the city of his grandparents, in 1945. Matt Konop became an honorary citizen of Domazlice on May 5, 2016.

Domazlice and Two Rivers became Sister Cities in May 2017.

A duplicate plaque, a gift to the city of Two Rivers from the Konop family, will be installed and unveiled on Sunday, July 1 at Two Rivers City Hall by Evelyn Raisleger, Matt Konop's sister. This ceremony will be part of a special public welcome event for the 10-person Sister City delegation from Domazlice.

A band concert and ice cream social will follow in Central Park beginning at 1:30 p.m.

At 4 p.m., Patrick Dewane will perform "The Accidental Hero" at the J. E. Hamilton Community House. \$10 admission tickets will be on sale at the door or available now at the Two Rivers Recreation Department and Schroeder's Department Store.
