Crack Sealing Program on City Streets

This Spring, DPW crews worked 1,056 hours filling cracks on 11 streets, not including work completed for the Library, Community House and City Hall.

Crack sealing helps prevent water seepage. In the winter, water seeping in and freezing causes separation and damage (such as potholes) to the roadway

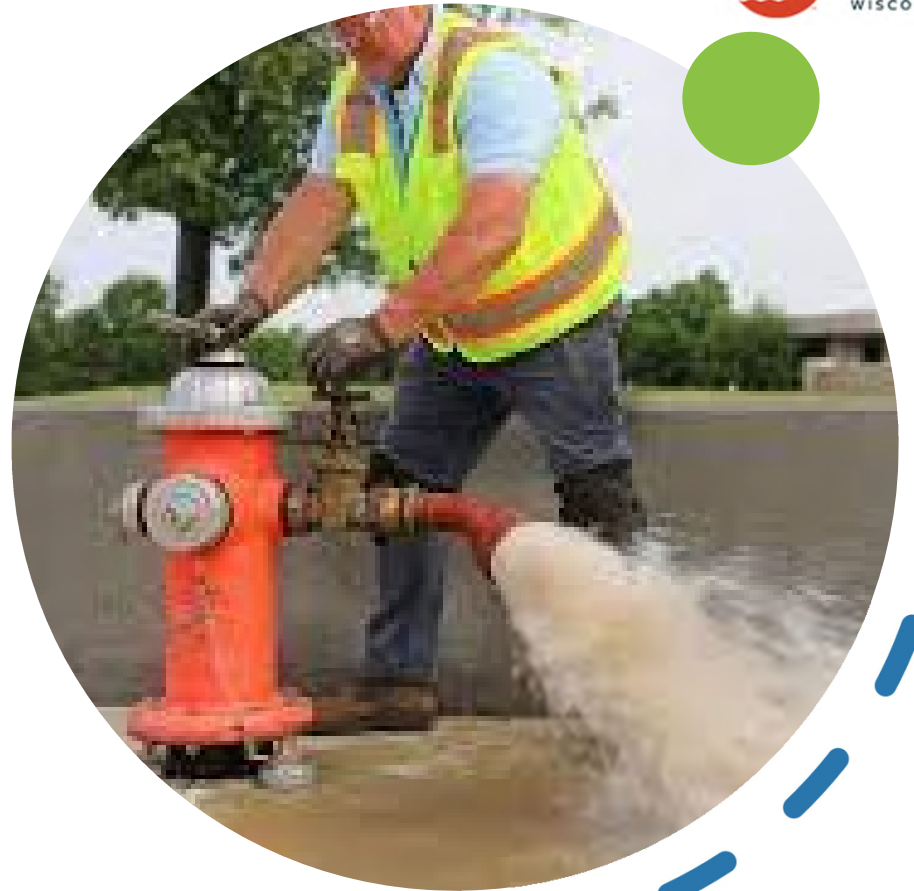
