

2. Thank You to City Electric Crews for Prompt Response to Widespread

Outage on Saturday Evening, October 23

The Line Crew responded to a widespread outage around 9:30 pm on Saturday, October 23rd, affecting the entire Eastside as well as the Northside of the City. Breakers for the circuits feeding the Northside and Eastside had tripped at the Columbus Street substation.

A big **thank you** to the Line Crew personnel for responding and being able to restore power in just over an hour.

- 3. Update on Status of Utility Accounts Receivable

Available cash balances in the City's various utilities were adversely impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic and the related moratorium on utility disconnects that started on November 1, 2019 and extended to April 15, 2021. ("Normal" moratorium on utility disconnects applies to residential customers only, and runs from each November 1 to April 15.)

Since April 2021, utility total receivables have improved considerably. Here is a snapshot of total utility receivables as of September 30 of the past three years:

September 30, 2019: \$1.70 million

2020: \$2.04 million (up 20% over 2019) 2021: \$1.86 million (up 9.4% over 2020)

Three lots have been sold so far in 2021 and four more are under contract for closing in November. Revenue to the City from lot sales in 2021 projected at \$197,000, after payment of realtor commission and closing costs.

Average assessed valuation for developed lots in the subdivision is about \$235,000, more than twice the average assessed valuation for single-family homes in the city.






