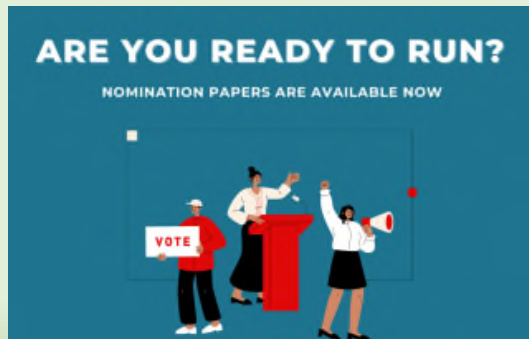

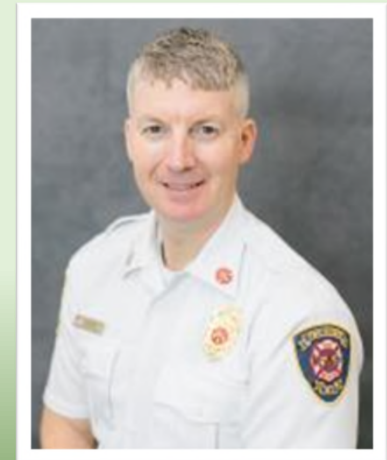

### 3. Central Park West Update

- Fund-Raising stands at **\$769,500**, or **96.2 percent** of the original goal of \$800,000
- City is striving to extend fund-raising to \$850,000, taking into account a slight increase in total estimated project cost, from \$1,600,000 to \$1,650,000
- Update on paver sales: 164 pavers of various sizes have been sold, raising a total of \$75,100; by area, pavers sold account for over 95 percent of the 100 SF area (four 5 by 5 foot squares) allotted for pavers in front of the stage. A fifth square will be added, and other areas are being evaluated for pavers.
- City crews have recently cleared the site for the stage and poured footings

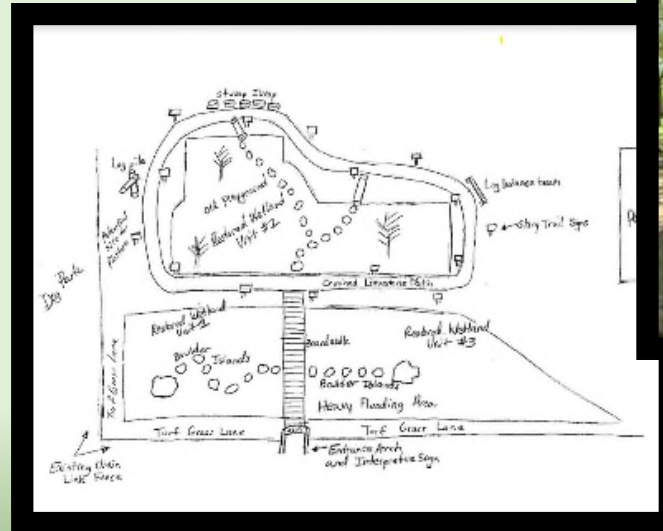

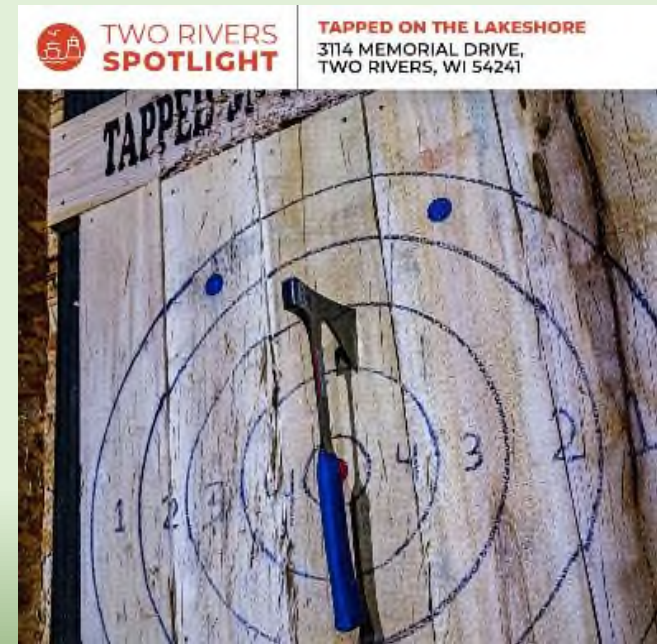
