

Media Release (Structure Fire) 23-0064

On 6/22/2023 at 1200 the City of Two Rivers Fire Department was dispatched to a report of a structure fire at 2831 10th Street in the City of Two Rivers. Upon arrival TRFD Engine 10 arrived on scene to find a 3-stall detached garage fully engulfed in flames which spread to a wood fence and an adjacent duplex on Columbus Street. The fire also caused significant exterior heat damage to a building east of the fire incident. Fire was called under control at 1355. There were no occupants in either structure and there were no injuries to any fire personnel. Estimated \$300,000 loss. Two families were displaced from this incident. The cause of the fire is currently being investigated by TRFD/TRPD and the State Fire Marshal. TRFD was assisted by City of Manitowoc, Town of Two Rivers, Mishicot, Two Creeks, Branch, Newton, Francis Creek, Valders and TRPD.




