Councilmember candidates for the April 2022 election can pick up candidacy and nomination paper packets for the April 2022 Spring Election in the City Clerk's office now.

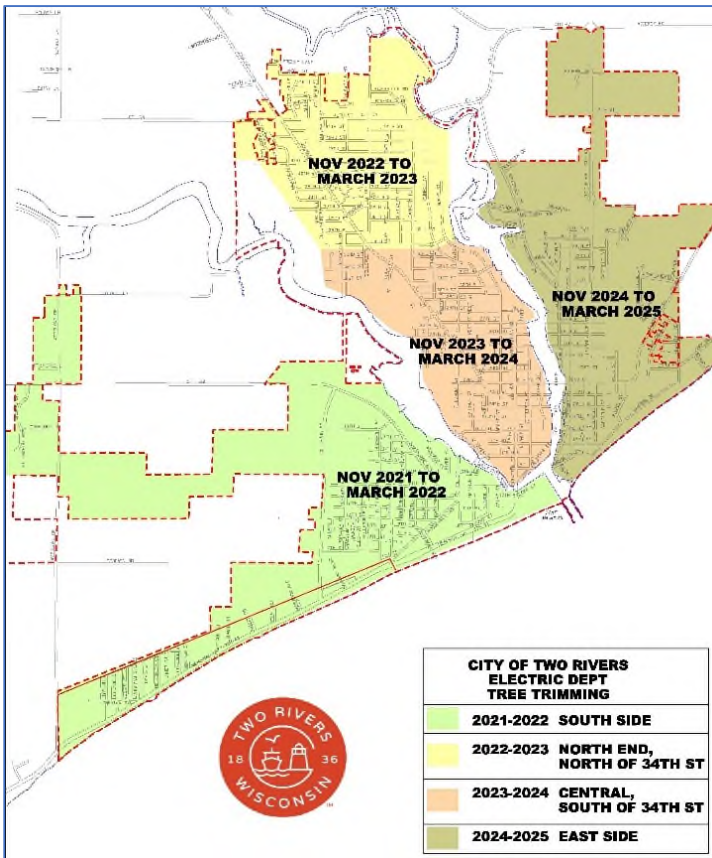
Candidates can choose to run for one of three vacancies for a 3-year term or one vacancy for a 2-year term. The following individuals will need to seek re-election if they wish to continue in their positions:

Councilmember, 3-year term: Mark Bittner  
Councilmember, 3-year term: Bill Leclair

Councilmember, 3-year term: Jay Remiker  
Councilmember, 2-year term: Larry Thomas

Candidacy paperwork and nomination papers are due back to the City Clerk no later than 5:00 pm on January 4th, 2022 for the 3-year term and 5:00 pm on January 11th, 2022 for the 2-year term.

### NOTICE WINTER PARKING EFFECTIVE DECEMBER 1 TO MARCH 15



Parking is prohibited on ANY PUBLIC STREET or in ANY MUNICIPAL PARKING LOT between 1:00 AM and 6:00 AM. Parking is limited to one hour between 1:30 AM and 6:00 AM on any public street in an area zoned business B-1, B-2 and B-3 or a nonconforming business use located in a residential district. Parking will be allowed on Christmas Day (December 25) and New Years Day (January 1) unless a snow emergency is declared.

*Authority - Two Rivers Municipal Ordinance 8-2-4.*

**Enforcement of the parking ban MAY be suspended at various times during the winter, depending on current conditions, the extended weather forecast, and the status of City snow or ice cleanup activities following storm events. Watch the Two Rivers Police Department and Two Rivers City Hall Facebook pages for updates.**
