## **CITY APPROVES WATER RATE INCREASE OF 8 PERCENT, TO TAKE EFFECT SEPTEMBER 1**



The City Council on June 19 authorized filing a “Simplified Rate Case” for the City’s water utility with the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin.

This filing will result in water rates increasing by 8 percent across the board, effective September 1. It has been five years since the last increase in water rates.

The increase is needed to help the utility cover increased operating costs for personnel, filtration membranes, chemicals and energy. Also to cover increased debt service resulting from needed capital investment in the water system, including replacement of lead water service laterals.

## **WEST RIVER LOFTS PROJECT CLOSER TO REALITY**



The City Council at its June 19 meeting approved a development agreement with West River Lofts, LLC to provide \$600,000 in City funding assistance to a \$14 million project that will construct 54 new apartments on a brownfield former industrial site along the West Twin River.

The development will be located on an open site between the former Eggers West plant and the old railroad bridge, on the west bank of the West Twin River. It will offer one, two, three and four bedroom units, many reserved for low and moderate income households, as well as market rate units
