## Mark Your Calendar for Memorial Day Observance

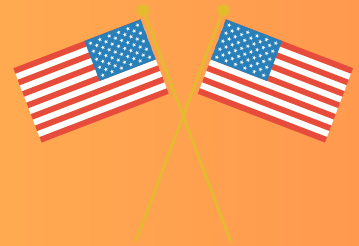
Along with the rest of our nation, Two Rivers pauses to say “thank you” on Memorial Day and to pay tribute to men and women who have given their lives in service to the United States of America in our U.S. military.

Activities begin in Central Park East at 8:15 a.m. with a reading of the honor roll and tolling of the bell to honor the 43 members of the U.S. Armed Forces from Two Rivers killed in action from the Civil War to the present. A wreath-laying ceremony will follow at the Soldiers Monument.

The parade begins at 9:00 AM, with route is as follows: starts at Washington and 18th Streets, north on Washington to 22nd Street, west to Forest Avenue, north to Calvary/ Pioneer Rest Cemetery, 1801 26th Street. At 9:30, a program will be held on the platform at the cemetery.

Following the program, the combined firing squads of the American Legion and Veterans of Foreign Wars will pay tribute to veterans at Forest View/Holy Cross Cemetery, 3801 Mishicot Road.

In the event of rain, the observance will be held in the Community House, 1710 West Park St.
