

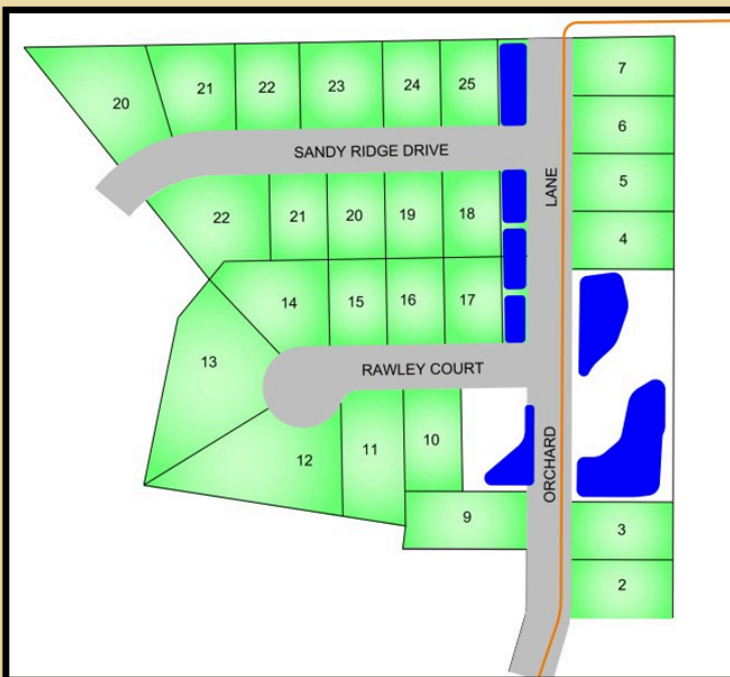

CITY MOVING FORWARD WITH PHASE 3 OF SANDY BAY SUBDIVISION

The City Council at its meeting on August 19 approved a contract with low bidder Advance Construction to extend utility and street infrastructure for the next phase of the conservation subdivision at the Sandy Bay Highlands.

Work is expected to begin in mid-September. Lots should be ready for construction by Spring/Summer 2025. Lot prices are expected to range from \$50,000 to \$75,000. Watch for more details in the near future. Oversight of lot sales and marketing is by the City's Community Development Authority.

Only one lot remains available in Phases 1 and 2 of the subdivision. The area has seen a flurry of new home construction activity in recent years, adding to our community's housing stock and tax base.
