F. Review Draft No. 1 of the Proposed Project Plan for Amendment No. 2 to TID No. 8 to assist with additional public infrastructure investment and business redevelopment within one-half mile of the boundaries of TID No. 8.

Ms. Runge provided a summary of the draft project plan for Amendment No. 2 for TID No. 8.

Ms. Kemp voiced concerns regarding the proposed Riverside expansion on nearby residences, specifically increases in parking, truck traffic, and visual impact. She also questioned if Riverside has requested a variance from the minimum street setback.

Mr. Buckley responded the Riverside expansion project was included in Amendment No. 1 for TID No. 8.

Plans for the Riverside expansion have not been submitted. Therefore, building footprint, parking, loading and landscaping is unknown at this time. Riverside shall submit site, architectural, lighting and landscaping plans for Plan Commission review.

Property owners within 200 feet of the Riverside property shall receive notice prior to the Plan Commission meeting regarding the plan review for the Riverside expansion project.

Ms. Runge added the City has received the application for variance. However, said application is incomplete and the City is waiting for additional documentation. Property owners shall received notice prior to the Board of Appeals meeting for said variance request.

G. Review Draft No. 1 of the Proposed Project Plan and Boundaries of TID No. 13 to support redevelopment of private properties and improvements to public infrastructure in the northern downtown business district
